ACER PALMATUM VARIETIES

Acer palmatum—JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing vase-like tree. Height 15-20--width 12-15 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Good yellow-gold fall color. Does well in containers. Often used as bonsai subject.

Acer palmatum ‘Aka Shigitatsu Sawa’—AKA SHIGITATSU SAWA JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing upright tree. Height 6-8 feet—width 4-6 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. New leaves are white, pink, and red, turning reddish green in summer. Good fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Akaji Nishiki’—AKAJI NISHIKI JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing upright tree. Height 7-8 feet—width 3-4 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Orange to pink spring growth turns green in summer. Bright orange fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Alpenweiss’—ALPENWEISS JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 15-20 feet—width 12-15 feet. Likes partial shade. Hardy to -5°F. Spectacularly variegated leaves are white, pink, and green. Good fall color. Does well in containers. Rare and unique variety!

Acer palmatum ‘Ao Kanzashi’—AO KANZASHI JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing upright tree. Height 12-15 feet—width 8-10 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Green leaves have thin purple margin. Golden fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Ao Shime No Uchi’—AO SHIME NO UCHI JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing upright tree. Height 8-10 feet—width 3-4 feet. Likes sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Light feathery look. Narrow red-purple leaves turn reddish bronze. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Atrolineare’—WILLOW LEAF JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing vase-like tree. Height 10-12 feet—width 8-10 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Narrow leaves are dark, black-red, turning bronze later. Fall color is bright red. Outstanding specimen tree.

Acer palmatum ‘Beni Gasa’—BENI GASA JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing bushy tree. Height 5-6 feet—width 4-5 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to 0°F. Horizontal branching variety—leaves red over green. Red, yellow, and orange fall color. Great bonsai subject. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Beni Hime’—BENI HIME JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing bushy tree. Height 3-4 feet—width 2-3 feet. Full sun. Hardy to 0°F. Pink to rusty red star-shaped leaves turn vibrant red in fall. Great bonsai subject. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Beni kawa’—RED BARK JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing rounded tree. Height 15-20 feet—width 12-15 feet. Likes sun. Hardy to -20°F. Green leaves in summer; yellow fall color. Winter bark is purer red than Coralbark Maple—colors at a younger age. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Beni Komachi’—BEAUTIFUL RED GIRL JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing rounded tree. Height 8-10 feet—width 6-8 feet. Likes sun or part shade. Hardy to 0°F. Beautiful bright pink-red new foliage in spring. Dwarf plant with dainty stems. Good fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Beni Maiko’—RED DANCER JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing upright tree. Height 8-12 feet—width 4-5 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Brilliant, bushy small tree. New leaves scarlet, turning pinkish red, then green. Good fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Beni Otake’—RED BAMBOO JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 8-10 feet—width 4-6 feet. Likes sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. A red linearlobum variety—narrow red leaves on horizontal branches. Looks like red bamboo! Good fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Beni Shi En’—RED SMOKE JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 8-12 feet—width 4-6 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to 0°F. Deeply divided leaves emerge rosy red, turning purple, then to medium green with light green midrib. Pinkish hues in late summer turns golden in fall.

Acer palmatum ‘Beni Schichihenge’—ORANGE PASTEL JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing upright tree. Height 5-6 feet—width 3-4 feet. Likes sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Green leaves are edged with a white margin—overlaid with pink and orange tones. Good fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Beni Tsukasa’—BENI TSUKASA JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing rounded tree. Height 4-5 feet—width 3-4 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Beautiful multi-hued foliage. Foliage emerges peach to orange-red, changes to delicate pink and red with greenish overtones. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Big Red’—BIG RED JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 8-12 feet—width 6-8 feet. Likes sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Large red leaves. Good fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Bloodgood’—BLOODGOOD JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing vase-like tree. Height 15-20 feet—width 15-18 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Bright red samaras. Excellent dark-red leaf color all summer. Good fall color—usually crimson. Does well in containers. Very popular variety.

Acer palmatum ‘Bonfire’—BONFIRE JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing upright tree. Height 10-12 feet—width 6-7 feet. Likes sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Crimson new growth turning green in summer. Showy flame-red fall color.

Acer palmatum ‘Burgundy Lace’—BURGUNDY LACE JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing vase-like tree. Height 10-12 feet—width 4-6 feet. Likes sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Deeply cut burgundy to bronze leaves. Does well in containers. **Protect from hot sun.**

Acer palmatum ‘Butterfly’—BUTTERFLY JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing vase-like, often stiffly upright tree. Height 5-7 feet—width 3-5 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -5°F. Dainty tree with cream and pale green variegation—in fall, white turns magenta. Does well in containers. **Protect from hot sun.**

Acer palmatum ‘Corallinum’—CORALLINUM JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing dense rounded tree. Height 5-7 feet—width 5-7 feet. Likes sun or part shade. Hardy to 0°F. Stunning shrimp pink spring foliage turning green. Scarlet fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Elizabeth’—ELIZABETH JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 5-7 feet—width 3-42 feet. Likes sun to part shade. Hardy to 0°F. Nice new dwarf red-leaved maple with deeply cut, purplish foliage.

Acer palmatum ‘Emperor I’—EMPEROR I (AKA RED EMPEROR) JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing open, airy tree. Height 12-15 feet—width 8-12 feet. Likes sun to part shade. Hardy to -20°F. The new Bloodgood! Deep purple red color holds well, turns dark crimson in fall.

Acer palmatum ‘Filifera purpurea’—PURPLE THREADLEAF JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing vase-like tree. Height 8-10 feet—width 6-8 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Dark purple leaves turning bronzy. Good fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Fireglow’—FIREGLOW JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing vase-like tree. Height 12-15 feet—width 10-12 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -20°F. Burgundy-red leaves hold color well. Good fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Glowing Embers’—GLOWING EMBERS JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing vase-like tree. Height 15-18 feet—width 12-14 feet. Sun or part shade. Tolerates heat better than most varieties. Hardy to -10°F. Dark green foliage turns all the shades of fire in fall—purple, red, fluorescent orange, and yellow, sometimes all on one branch. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Higasayama’—HIGASAYAMA JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing upright tree. Height 10-12 feet—spread 6-8 feet. Likes sun or part shade. Hardy to -10° F. Spectacular when cream-sheathed crimson buds open; leaf color and shape change dramatically through the season.

Acer palmatum ‘Hogyoku’—HOGYOKU JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 12-15 feet—width 6-9 feet. Likes sun to part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Round bright green leaves. Pumpkin orange fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Iijima Sunago’—SPRINKLED SAND JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 15-25 feet—width 10-15 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. New leaves orange-red, turning purple-brown with green “sprinkles”. Good orange, red, and yellow fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Inazuma’—THUNDER JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing rounded tree. Height 10-12 feet—width 6-8 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to 0°F. Deeply divided purple to green leaves turn bright crimson in fall. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Japanese Sunrise’—JAPANESE SUNRISE JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 12-14 feet—width 8-12 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Showy red to yellow stems—better color than Coral Bark Maple. Green foliage—orange fall color.

Acer palmatum ‘Johnnie’s Pink’—JOHNNIE’S PINK JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing rounded tree. Height 10-15 feet. Sun or part shade. Yellow to orange fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Kagiri Nishiki’—KAGIRI NISHIKI JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing upright tree. Height 10-12 feet—width 5-6 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -5°F. Small green leaves have rose and cream colored edges. Orange-gold fall color.

Acer palmatum ‘Kandy Kitchen’—KANDY KITCHEN JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 5-7 feet—spread 4-5 feet. Likes sun to part shade. Hardy to 0°F. Good dark red color holds well on this dwarf tree. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Karasugawa’—PINK-LEAFED JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing upright tree. Height 6-8 feet—width 4-6 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to 0°F. New leaves bright pink and white. Good fall color. Does well in containers. Spectacular specimen plant. **Protect from hot sun.**

Acer palmatum ‘Kasagiyama’—KASAGIYAMA JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing mounding tree. Height 3-5 feet—width 4-5 feet. Likes sun or part shade. Hardy to -20°F. Brick red to salmon-colored leaves with green by veins—very unusual variegated variety. Color varies in sun or shade. Good fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Kasen Nishiki’—KASEN NISHIKI JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 10-15 feet—width 6-8 feet. Likes sun to part shade. Hardy to 0°F. Beautiful new variegated form—pink-red or light orange-red mixed with cream.

Acer palmatum ‘Katsura’—KATSURA DWARF JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing rounded tree. Height 6-8 feet—width 4-6 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to 0°F. Yellow-orange new growth turns green in summer, orange and yellow in fall. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Kinran’—KINRAN JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing rounded tree. Height 10-12 feet—width 8-10 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Rich purple color with green veining. Spectacular fall color—crimson and gold. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Koto No Ito’—KOTO NO ITO JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing upright tree. Height 6-8 feet—width 4-5 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to 0°F. Narrow green leaves turn shades of yellow in fall. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Kurui jishi’—KURUI JISHI JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 8-10 feet—width 4-6 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to 0°F. Great for a small yard. Deep green star-shaped leaves turn yellow in fall. Edges of leaves curl upwards. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Lozita’—LOZITA DWARF JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing rounded tree. Height 6-8 feet—width 4-6 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to 0°F. Deep purple-red leaves—like a dwarf form of ‘Bloodgood’. One of the darkest forms. Good fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Margaret Bee’—MARGARET BEE JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 15 feet—width 10-12 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Red Japanese Maple

Acer palmatum ‘Mizuho Beni’—MIZUHO BENI JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 15-18 feet—width 12-14 feet. Likes sun to part shade. Hardy to 0°F. Orange-yellow leaves with dark pink leaf edges in spring. A great addition to the katsura group.

Acer palmatum ‘Murasaki kiyohime’—DWARF PURPLE TIP JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing rounded tree. Height 3-4 feet—width 3-4 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to 0°F. Small green leaves with purple tips turn orange in fall. Slow growing—excellent for bonsai, containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Nicholsonii’—NICHOLSONII JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 10-15 feet—width 8-12 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to 0°F. Olive green foliage turns brilliant yellow or crimson in fall.

Acer palmatum ‘Nuresagi’—WET HERON JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing rounded tree. Height and width 12-18 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to 0°F. Strong, deep red-purple-black color. Hardy, upright, and vigorous. Good red fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘O jishi’—COMPACT LION JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing vasselike tree. Height 6-8 feet—spread 4-5 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -5° F. Uncommon variety; like a dense, compact ‘Shishigashira’. Orange fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Ogon Sarasa’—GOLD CALICO JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing rounded tree. Height 15-18 feet—width 8-12 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Early leaves brick red over green, turning green in summer. Orange and crimson fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Okagami’—OKAGAMI JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing rounded tree. Height 12-15 feet—width 10-15 feet. Likes sun. Hardy to 0°F. New leaves purplish-red darkening to blackish-red with green tones in late summer. Turns glowing red in fall.

Acer palmatum ‘Omato’—OMATO JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 10-12 feet—width 8-10 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to 0°F. Orange-red in spring—orange and red fall color.

Acer palmatum ‘Orange Dream’—ORANGE DREAM JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing upright tree. Height 5-6 feet—spread 3-4 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Bright orange new growth turns lemon-yellow tipped with red. Slowly turns to yellow green in summer, then bright yellow-gold in fall. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Orido Nishiki’—ORIDO NISHIKI JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing upright tree. Height 15-20 feet—width 10-12 feet. Likes partial shade. Hardy to -10°F. Unique pink, white and green spring foliage—good fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Osakazuki’—FLAME-LEAF JAPANESE MAPLE. Fast growing upright tree. Height 15-25 feet—width 10-20 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Rich green in spring and summer—intense crimson fall color. The best for autumn display! Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Oshu shidare’—OSHU SHIDARE JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing rounded tree. Height 8-10 feet—width 10-12 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to 0°F. Pendulous branches. Stong purple-red deeply cut leaves turn crimson in fall. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Otome Zakura’—OTOME ZAKURA JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing tree. Height 10-12 feet—width 6-8 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Brilliant flame to pink flame spring color—turns red green in summer. Good fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Peaches & Cream’—PEACHES & CREAM JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing upright tree. Height 6-8 feet—width 4-6 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. New leaves are greenish cream with rose overlay and green veins. Gold to buff fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum 'Pixie'—PIXIE DWARF JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing rounded tree. Height 6-9 feet—width 5-8 feet. Likes sun. Hardy to -10°F. Very attractive form with dark red leaves. Maroon fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum 'Purple Ghost'—PURPLE GHOST JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing tree. Height 10-12 feet. Sun or part shade. Purple leaves with black veins. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum 'Red Cloud'—RED CLOUD JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing tree. Height 12-15 feet—width 7-9 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Rosy-red new growth—red purple summer color holds well.

Acer palmatum 'Red Crusader'—RED CRUSADER JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 12-15 feet—width 6-8 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to 0°F. New and improved Bloodgood type.

Acer palmatum 'Red Pygmy'—RED PYGMY JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing rounded tree. Height 5-6 feet—width 3-4 feet. Likes sun. Hardy to 0°F. Thin, narrow leaves red-maroon in spring and summer-bronze if in direct sunlight. Good fall color. Does well in containers. Looks like red bamboo.

Acer palmatum 'Red Spider'—RED SPIDER JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 8-12 feet—width 6-8 feet. Likes sun. Hardy to 0°F. Slender red leaves. Good fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum 'Red Wood'—RED WOOD JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 8-12 feet—width 4-8 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to 0°F. A redder form of Coral-Bark Maple—barks holds color well. Yellow fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum 'Roseomarginatum'—ROSEOMARGINATUM JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 8-12 feet—spread 6-8 feet. Likes sun. Hardy to 5°F. Small green leaves have rose and cream colored edges. Orange-gold fall color.

Acer palmatum 'Ruby Ridge'—RUBY RIDGE JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 6-10 feet—width 4-6 feet. Likes partial shade. Hardy to 0°F. More shrublike form with large red leaves. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum 'Ruby Stars'—RUBY STARS DWARF JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing rounded tree. Height 4-5 feet—spread 3-4 feet. Sun or part shade. New leaves emerge ruby red—contrast with green older foliage. Gold and crimson fall color. Good container plant.

Acer palmatum 'Ryuzu'—RYUZU DWARF JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing rounded tree. Height 5-10 feet—spread 5-10 feet. Sun or part shade. New leaves are flushed pink; turn green, often edged with brick red. Good fall color. Good container plant.

Acer palmatum 'Sagara Nishiki'—GOLD LINE JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing rounded tree. Height 6-9 feet—width 5-8 feet. Likes part shade. Hardy to 0°F. Very unusual large leaves—green with yellow dots around the margin and pinkish overlay. Burns in direct sunlight. Good fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Saku’—SAKU JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 8-10 feet—width 4-5 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to 0°F. Purple new growth in spring. Yellow fall color.

Acer palmatum ‘Sango Kaku’—CORAL BARK JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing vase-like tree. Height 15-20 feet—width 8-12 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Light green leaf turning gold with light red in fall. Coral bark is striking in winter. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Sazanami’--SAZANAMI JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing upright tree. Height 10-12 feet—width 6-8 feet. Likes sun. Hardy to -10°F. Sharply serrated leaves emerge orange-red, becoming green. Strong gold blends in fall. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum X shirasawanum ‘Sensu’--SENSU JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing rounded tree. Height 8-12 feet—width 6-8 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Leaves have green veins and a coral margin. Outstanding orange fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Shaina’—SHAINA DWARF JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing oval tree. Height 7-10 feet—width 4-5 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. A dwarf, compact sport of ‘Bloodgood’. Becomes dense with maturity. Deep red leaves turn crimson in fall. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Sharp’s Pygmy’—SHARP’S PYGMY JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing rounded tree. Height 2-3 feet—width 2-3 feet. Likes sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Small leaves are green with purple overtones. Excellent bonsai specimen. Orange to red fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Shigitatsu sawa’—SHIGITATSU SAWA JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing rounded tree. Height 5-8 feet—width 4-6 feet. Likes partial shade. Hardy to -10°F. Leaves emerge white, turn yellow-white with green veins. Red to rich red-green in fall. Grows 4-6 inches a year. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Shigure bato’—SHIGURE BATO JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing upright tree. Height 5-7 feet—width 4-6 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to 5°F. Beautiful feathery leaves—reddish in spring, turning green. Gold to crimson in fall. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Shindeshojo’—SHINDESHOJO JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing spreading tree. Height 4-6 feet—spread 4-6 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to 0°F. Flaming scarlet new foliage turns reddish green in summer. Red and orange fall color. Good bonsai subject—good in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Shishigashira’—SHISHIGASHIRA JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing upright tree. Height 4-6 feet—width 2-3 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to 0°F. Bright green, crinkled foliage. Orange fall color. Good patio tree or bonsai. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Shojo Numera’—SHOJO NUMERA JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing spreading tree with good branching. Height 6-8 feet—width 6-8 feet. Likes partial shade. Hardy to -20°F. Large dark purple leaves on long red stems “dance” in the smallest breeze. Red fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Skeeter’s Broom’—SKEETER’S BROOM JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing narrow upright tree. Height 4-5 feet—spread 3-4 feet. Likes sun. Hardy to -10°F. Very rare! Bright red foliage turns purple-red; holds color well through the summer. Rich red fall color. Excellent patio plant or bonsai.

Acer palmatum ‘Suminagashi’—SUMINAGASHI JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing vase-like tree. Height 8-10 feet—width 3-5 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to 0°F. Bright purple-red in spring, becoming very deep maroon, then crimson in fall. Small red flowers followed by red samaras. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Tiger Rose’—TIGER ROSE JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing tree. Height 5-6 feet—width 4-5 feet. Sun or part shade. Light green leaves with prominent veins. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Tsuma Gaki’—TSUMA GAKI JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 8-10 feet—width 4-5 feet. Likes partial shade. Hardy to 0°F. Yellow green leaves with purple tips. Yellow/crimson fall color.

Acer palmatum ‘Ukigumo’—FLOATING CLOUD JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing upright tree. Height 8-12 feet—width 4-6 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to 0°F. Beautiful landscape specimen—foliage is pastel pink, green, and white. Does well in containers. **Protect from hot sun to prevent sunburn.**

Acer palmatum ‘V. Corbin’—V. CORBIN JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree with cascading branches. Height 12-15 feet—width 10-12 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Delicate green leaves. Good fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Villa Taranto’—VILLA TARANTO JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing mounding tree. Height 6-8 feet—width 5-6 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Wonderful ornamental tree. Foliage is green with light reddish overtones. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Wabito’—LONELY MAN JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing upright tree. Height 3-4 feet—width 2-3 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -5°F. Beautiful miniature landscape specimen—unusual, many-shaped leaves. Scarlet fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Weumpka Red’—WEUMPKA RED JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 8-10 feet—width 4-6 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Dark red foliage all summer on a thick grower.

Acer palmatum ‘Winter Flame’—WINTER FLAME JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing bushy tree. Like a dwarf ‘Sango Kaku’—striking coral bark in winter. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum ‘Wou nishiki’—WOU NISHIKI JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 12-15—width 6-8 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -5°F. Bright yellow new leaves edged rose, turning bright green in summer, scarlet in fall. Good in a narrow, small area. Does well in containers.

ACER PALMATUM LACELEAF VARIETIES

Acer palmatum dissectum ‘Baldsmith’—BALDSMITH LACELEAF MAPLE. Medium growing mounding tree. Height 5-6 feet—width 5-8 feet. Likes sun to part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Apricot-salmon new growth turns to green flushed with pink. Very beautiful red-orange fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum dissectum ‘Brocade’—BROCADE LACELEAF MAPLE. Slow growing cascading shrub. Height 4-5 feet—width 5-7 feet. Sun or part shade. Deep but soft red foliage holds color well. Good fall color—bright red blended with orange. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum dissectum ‘Crimson Queen’—CRIMSON QUEEN LACELEAF MAPLE. Slow growing rounded shrub. Height 3-6 feet—width 5-6 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -25°F. Dark red leaves all summer—bright scarlet in fall. Most popular laceleaf maple. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum dissectum ‘Ebony’—EBONY LACELEAF MAPLE. Slow growing weeping shrub. Height 3-4 feet—spread 6-8 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Dark red color holds well. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum dissectum ‘Filigree’—FILIGREE LACELEAF MAPLE. Slow growing mounding shrub. Height 4-5 feet—spread 5-6 feet. Likes partial shade. Hardy to -10°F. Variegated foliage. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum dissectum ‘Flavescens’—FLAVESCENS LACELEAF MAPLE. Medium growing mounding shrub. Height 5-6 feet—width 6-8 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to 0°F. Very yellow new growth in spring; strong yellow fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum dissectum ‘Garnet’—GARNET LACELEAF MAPLE. Slow growing rounded shrub. Height and width 4-8 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Holds dark orange-red leaf color all summer. Vigorous grower. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum dissectum ‘Geisha’—GEISHA LACELEAF MAPLE. Slow growing mounding shrub. Height 2-3 feet—width 2-3 feet. Likes partial shade. Hardy to 5°F. Delicate pink and cream to yellow green tones persist all through summer. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum dissectum ‘Green Hornet’—GREEN HORNET LACELEAF MAPLE. Medium growing mounding tree. Height 3-8 feet—width 4-8 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to 0°F. Vigorous grower with great green foliage. Good fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum dissectum ‘Green Mist’—GREEN MIST LACELEAF MAPLE. Slow growing mounding tree. Height 4-5 feet—width 3-4 feet. Likes sun to part shade. Hardy to 0°F. Very deeply cut leaves are green misted with red-pink. Good fall color. Does well in containers. **Protect from hot sun.**

Acer palmatum dissectum ‘Inaba Shidare’—INABA SHIDARE LACELEAF MAPLE. Slow growing mounding shrub. Height 3-4 feet—width 4-5 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to 0°F. One of the darkest purple-red laceleaves—holds color all summer. Brilliant crimson in fall. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum dissectum 'Julien'—JULIEN LACELEAF MAPLE. Slow growing mounding tree. Height 4-5 feet—width 4-5 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to 0°F. Bright green delicate leaves. Orange-yellow fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum dissectum 'Midori no teiboku'—MIDORI NO TEIBOKU LACELEAF MAPLE. Slow growing spreading shrub. Height 2-3 feet—spread 6-7 feet. Sun or part shade. Dark green foliage. Yellow to orange fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum dissectum 'Orangeola'—ORANGEOLA LACELEAF MAPLE. Slow growing mounding shrub. Height 3-5 feet—width 4-6 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Red color fades a bit in summer, then turns brilliant orange-red in fall. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum dissectum 'Red Dragon'—RED DRAGON LACELEAF MAPLE. Slow growing rounded shrub. Height and width 3-4 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Deepest red laceleaf maple—perhaps the best red color in any Japanese maple. Scarlet in fall. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum 'Red Filigree Lace'—RED FILIGREE LACE JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing vase-like tree. Height 6-8 feet—width 4-5 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -5°F. Slow growing, small vase-shaped tree. Deep purple-red turning light crimson in fall. Great in containers.

Acer palmatum dissectum 'Tamukeyama'--BOLDRED LACELEAF MAPLE. Slow growing mounding shrub. Height and width 5-6 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to 0°F. Very dark purple-red foliage holds color well. Wonderful landscape specimen. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum dissectum 'Toyama Nishiki'—TOYAMA NISHIKI LACELEAF MAPLE. Slow growing mounding shrub. Height 4-5 feet—width 3-5 feet. Needs shade. Hardy to 10°F. Purple-red with pink or white variegation. Colors most intense in shade. Does well in containers. **Protect from hot sun.**

Acer palmatum dissectum 'Van den Akker'—VAN DEN AKKER LACELEAF MAPLE. Slow growing rounded shrub. Height 3-6 feet—width 5-6 feet. Sun or part shade. Branches are more horizontal than weeping. Two toned foliage is green and dark brown red. Does well in containers.

Acer palmatum dissectum 'Viridis'--GREEN LACELEAF MAPLE. Slow growing rounded shrub. Height 2-6 feet—width 3-6 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Intense light green color all summer. Yellow and orange in fall. Does well in containers.

OTHER SPECIALTY MAPLES

Acer campestre compacta—GLOBE MAPLE. Slow growing rounded tree. Height 6-8 feet—width 4-6 feet. Sun or part shade. Yellow fall color. Hardy to -10°F.

Acer campestre ‘Carnival’—CARNIVAL HEDGE MAPLE. Medium growing rounded tree. Height 8-10 feet—spread 8-10 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -25°F. Variegated leaves splashed with pink, green, and white. Good container plant.

Acer campestre ‘Royal Ruby’—ROYAL RUBY HEDGE MAPLE. Medium growing rounded tree. Height 10-15 feet—width 6-10 feet. Likes sun. Hardy to -10°F. Striking purple-red new foliage, red twigs. Good tree for small area.

Acer circinatum—VINE MAPLE. Medium growing vasselike tree. Height 15-20 feet—width 10-12 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Open, wispy growth. Pacific Northwest native. Green foliage turns red, yellow, or orange in fall. Does well in containers.

Acer circinatum ‘Monroe’—MONROE VINE MAPLE. Medium growing vasselike tree. Height 10-12 feet—width 10-12 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -210°F. Laceleaf variety with purplish branches—from the Cascade Mountains. Good yellow fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer circinatum ‘Pacific Fire’—PACIFIC FIRE VINE MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 10-12 feet—width 8-10 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Excellent newer variety with orange and purple new growth turning to chartreuse blushed pink. Red bark in winter. Yellow fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer circinatum ‘Sunny Sister’—SUNNY SISTER VINE MAPLE. Slow growing upright shrub. Height 5-6 feet—width 3-4 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to 0°F. Apricot colored new leaves. Golden fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer ginnala ‘Flame’—FLAME AMUR MAPLE. Medium growing rounded tree. Height 15-20 feet—spread 12-15 feet. Likes sun. Hardy to -40°F. Fragrant yellowish flowers in spring; fiery red fall color.

Acer griseum—PAPERBARK MAPLE. Slow growing pyramidal tree. Height 20-25 feet—spread 8-15 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Unusual reddish peeling bark. Brilliant red fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer griseum x pseudoplatanus—GRISEUM x PSEUDOPLATANUS MAPLE. Slow growing pyramidal tree. Height 12-14 feet—spread 6-10 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to 0°F. Larger green leaves with reddish stems than straight paperbark. Hoping bark will peel like parent. Red fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer japonicum ‘Aconitifolium’—FERNLEAF FULL MOON MAPLE. Slow growing rounded tree. Height and width 10-12 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Prominent white and maroon flower ins sping. Deeply cut leaves. Excellent scarlet fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer japonicum ‘Green Cascade’—GREEN CASCADE JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing weeping shrub. Height 3-5 feet—width 5-7 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Brilliant fall color—very finely divided leaves. Does well in containers. Rare and choice variety.

Acer japonicum ‘Lovett’—LOVETT JAPANESE MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 10-12 feet—width 6-8 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Very attractive upright tree with small green leaves. Excellent fall color. Does well in containers.

Acer japonicum ‘Otaki’—OTAKI JAPANESE MAPLE. Slow growing rounded tree. Height and width 15-20 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Rich green foliage—almost blue green in shade. Good fall color—crimson, gold and orange.

Acer macrophyllum ‘Mocha Rose’—MOCHA ROSE MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 12-15 feet—width 6-8 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to 0°F. This cultivar of our native bigleaf maple lives up to the name—the foliage is a unique blend of mocha and rose.

Acer negundo ‘Flamingo’—VARIEGATED BOX ELDER. Medium growing upright tree. Height 15-20 feet—width 8-12 feet. Likes sun. Hardy to -5°F. Nice variegated street or yard tree—green leaves tipped with pink fading to white.

Acer negundo ‘Winter Lightning’—WINTER LIGHTNING BOX ELDER. Medium growing upright tree. Height 25-30 feet—width 15-25 feet. Likes sun. Hardy to -5°F. Bright yellow fall color. Twigs and branches electric yellow in winter.

Acer platanoides ‘Columnare’—COLUMNAR NORWAY MAPLE. Rapid growing columnar tree. Height 30-40 feet—spread 10-15 feet. Likes sun. Hardy to -25°F. Good fall color. Excellent street tree.

Acer platanoides ‘Crimson Sentry’—CRIMSON SENTRY NORWAY MAPLE. Medium growing columnar tree. Height 20-25 feet—width 10-12 feet. Likes sun. Hardy to -15°F. Handsome tree. Good street tree—dense foliage. Good crimson fall color.

Acer pseudoplatanus ‘Eskimo Sunset’—ESKIMO SUNSET SYCAMORE MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 12-16 feet—spread 8-12 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -20°F. Striking pink leaves speckled with green.

Acer pseudoplatanus ‘Prinz Hanjery’—PRINZ HANJERY SYCAMORE MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 18-25 feet—spread 10-12 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Striking pink-red leaves with gold-green margins.

Acer pseudoplatanus ‘Puget Pink’—PUGET PINK SYCAMORE MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 15-20 feet—spread 12-15 feet. Likes sun. Hardy to -10°F. Striking shrimp pink new growth. A Heronswood introduction.

Acer pseudosieboldianum—FALSE SIEBOLD’S MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 12-15 feet—width 10-12 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Leaves bluish-green, almost translucent when backlit by sun. Yellow and scarlet in fall. Does well in containers.

Acer rubescens ‘Silver Cardinal’—SILVER CARDINAL SNAKEBARK MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 8-10 feet—spread 3-4 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to 0°F. Wild pink and cream variegated foliage—red petioles and young twigs, bark striped cream, green, or red. Very striking plant.

Acer rufinerve ‘Albolimbata’—HATSUYUKI KAEDE SNAKEBARK MAPLE. Medium growing rounded tree. Height 20-25 feet—width 18-20 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Intriguing rough bark with red veins in winter. Excellent red fall color.

Acer rufinerve ‘Erythrocladum’—ERYTHROCLADUM HONSHU SNAKEBARK MAPLE. Slow growing vase-like tree. Height 8-10 feet—width 3-4 feet. Likes sun. Hardy to -10°F. Intriguing rough bark with red veins in winter in a manageable size tree. Good fall color.

Acer shirasawanum (Aka A. japonicum) ‘Aureum’—GOLDEN FULL MOON MAPLE. Medium growing rounded tree. Height 8-10 feet—width 6-8 feet. Part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Yellow leaves all summer. Fall colors of orange through red, sometimes purple. Does well in containers. **Protect from hot sun.**

Acer shirasawanum ‘Autumn Moon’—AUTUMN MOON PALM-LEAFED MAPLE. Medium growing rounded tree. Height 8-10 feet—width 6-8 feet. Sun or part shade—cannot take hot sun. Hardy to -10°F. Yellow leaf flush rose in the summer, turning peachy orange in fall.

Acer siebolianum ‘Ogurayama’—OGURAYAMA DWARF SIEBOLD’S MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 10-12 feet—spread 5-7 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Slight gold cast to leaves. Striking bright red fall color.

Acer siebolianum ‘Sode no uchi’—DWARF SIEBOLD’S MAPLE. Slow growing rounded shrub. Height 3-4 feet—spread 3-4 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -5°F. Bright light green foliage. Yellow with red fall color. Excellent bonsai specimen. Good container plant.

Acer tegmentosum ‘White Tigress’—WHITE TIGRESS SNAKE BARK MAPLE. Medium growing upright tree. Height 20-25 feet—width 12-15 feet. Sun or part shade. Hardy to -10°F. Yellow-green flowers in early spring, yellow fall color. Ornamental bark—bright white stripes against gray-green bark. The bark tells the story of a tigress sharpening her claws.
