CRABAPPLE VARIETIES 2012

ADIRONDACK. Height 18 feet—width 10 feet. Dense foliage, upright form. Waxy white flowers followed by bright red jewel-like ½” fruit. Good disease resistance.

DOLGO. Height and width 25-30 feet. Upright spreading shape. White flowers, red oval 1½” fruit. Edible variety—great for making ruby red jelly.

JAPANESE (*Malus floribunda*). Height and width 15-20 feet. Broad, dense grower. Deep pink buds open to fragrant white flowers, extremely profuse bloomer. Dense green foliage. Small red and yellow apples in fall. Moderate disease resistance.

PINK PRINCESS. Height 6-8 feet—width 10-12 feet. Spreading dwarf tree. Fragrant rose-pink flowers. Deep red fruit in fall. Excellent disease resistance.

PRAIRIFIRE. Height and width 15-20 feet. Upright rounded shape. Bright pinkish red flowers; fruit dark purple-red, ½”. Purple new foliage becoming reddish green. Outstanding orange fall color. Reddish bark. Good disease resistance.

RED BARON. Height 16-18 feet—spread 6-8 feet. Upright columnar form. Dark red flowers. Purple foliage; dark red fruit in fall. Great for that tight spot.

ROYAL RAINDROPS. Height 18 feet—width 12-15 feet. One of the best new cultivars with its neat upright form. Pinkish red flowers. Purplish cut leaf foliage. Disease resistant. Abundant ¼” bright red fruit in fall. Orange-red fall color.

RUBY TEARS WEEPING. Height 8-10 feet—width 12-15 feet. Weeping form. Fragrant pink flowers. Purple new foliage becoming reddish green. Ruby red fruit in fall.

SHOW TIME. Height and width 10-15 feet. Upright pyramidal shape. Bright fuchsia red flowers; fruit is cherry red. Purple new foliage becoming reddish green. Good disease resistance.
