

**KEEP IN MIND:** There are no plants that are truly 100% rabbit proof. The ones on this list will bounce back quickly after being nibbled on, or have plant material that will not be appetizing to rabbits, except as a last resort. Plants may also be more susceptible to damage in the early stages of growth, so offering protection at first may be helpful.
