

Few plants are completely deer proof. Young deer may try anything and their tastes change according to the season and availability of food. These plants are less likely to be bothered, due to tough, fuzzy, or bad-tasting foliage or bark. Young trees may need to be fenced in the fall when deer rub their antlers on branches to remove the velvet.

-  **FULL SUN** - 6 hours of direct light, including the mid-day sun.
-  **PART SUN** - Full sun in mornings and late afternoon; shade at mid-day.
-  **FULL SHADE** - These plants will often burn in direct sunlight, and thrive in 6 or more hours of shade.
-  **DROUGHT TOLERANT**- These plants will tolerate drought conditions once they are established.
